- Brad VanPelt would like to be a volunteer coach, high interest
- Eddy Boggs has announced that this is his last year as head archery coach
 - Eddy Boggs will stay on as an advisor for the archery team
 - Eddy Boggs would like to have clinics to continue to build the team
 - Clinics will allow focus on different aspects of archery
 - Joe Janz will become the new head coach when the season ends
 - Joe's new lead role will begin on September 1, 2021

SHOTGUN:

- Ammunition Grant
 - YSSA has 2 pallets of ammunition
 - Where can this be stored?
 - Back room at the range - Tim Baldwin suggestion
 - Located in the back near the woman's bathroom - large closet
 - Prefer not to leave the ammunition in New Boston, IL
 - Too much work to get a volunteer to pick it up and transport the ammunition
- Bi-State
 - Thursdays are currently open for anyone to practice shotgun skills
 - Tim Baldwin stated that this could change if the YSSA athletes return to practice on Thursday nights
- Coaches for Shotgun
 - Currently no one has shown an interest in being the head coach for shotgun

- Not interested in being a coach with YSSA

Midway USA

- YSSA purchased a pallet of ammunition
 - Would it be possible to sell the ammunition by the case to athletes due to the shortage of locating ammunition during COVID?
 - Can we limit the purchase to a maximum of 2 flats to be sure those interested are able to pick up supplies?
 - What would be the appropriate price to sell a flat at?
 - Who would be interested in going to Bi-State to disperse the ammunition?
