# YSSA October 4, 2021 Board Meeting Minutes

## **YSSA Registration Success!!!**

- New Members have filled out paperwork
- Next TeamSnap will need to be updated
  - o Get paperwork to Bill Peterson about athletes and the fees that were paid
    - Some previous athletes needed to get additional clarification about their fees
      - This will need to be addressed by Bill Peterson
        - Families are Dassie and Strong
        - Some thought they had already paid
- Several of the families who attended the registration night was not aware of this program
- Many were impressed with the location and excited about the prospects regarding this club for the youth
- 17 checks were collected
  - More will come in as they attend practice
  - Remember only on registration night sign up for new members did they get the 10% discount
  - NO COLLECTION FOR SCTP or SASP for shotgun or pistol

## Archery:

- Entry fees for Archery
  - Charged \$60.00
    - \$15.00 will go into each account
      - New athlete or existing

#### Shotgun:

- Kyle Minneart is on overtime
  - No new shotgun startup at this time
  - Give new shooting athletes Kyle's information to be contacted to begin a course
- Shotgun practices begin at 4:30 on Thursdays
  - This is not only for YSSA youth, so do not assume that we have the use of the entire range
  - Encourage the athletes to be patient and respectful of the range facility
- Options and requirements:
  - o ATA begins at 8 years old, national organization not based on your state of residence
  - 4H 10 years old and up, this is the only shotgun option no matter which side of the river you reside
  - September 1 is the beginning of the year for ATA and 4H
    - Annual renewals are due

- ALL shotgun athletes must have hunter safety to participate with YSSA
- New shooter athletes started showed up, but Kyle was not there.
  - A notice should have been placed in TeamSnap to notify the new athletes about this
- **TeamSnap** roster needs to be a priority this is how we communicate with the entire team.
  - Be sure to remove any athletes that have aged out, or have decided not to return
  - Bill Peterson has promised to get this updated within the next 2 days

## Pistol, Air Rifle, and Rifle:

- Still looking for a coach
- Tom Davidson is interested, but Bill Peterson needs to follow up with him.
  - Tom Davidson is a coach with the PV Trap team, but stated at registration that he is more comfortable with the use of pistols and rifles

### **Future of YSSA Indoor Range:**

- The indoor range has been a gift for several years, but as all things there comes a time when change must happen
- Current Standing:
  - o Indoor Range has a monthly expense of \$1,500.00 which is \$17,000.00 a year for rent
    - This is not an option for YSSA. These fees would quickly delete the bank account.
    - What are the options available to the archery club?
    - Need to have a further discussion with Tim Baldwin
      - Bill Peterson will follow up with Tim about a time line
  - Indoor Range plus internet would send the monthly expense at \$2,000.00
  - Increasing revenue for YSSA Options:
    - Retail arms:
      - Sales
      - not for profit
      - bow deck= cost for practice, YSSA would need to support it
    - Partner with another facility for indoor archery practice
      - Davenport Archery?
        - Davenport Archers YSSA may need to do this sooner than later
        - Would this still be an option since the last time YSSA talked to them?
        - Need to have a further discussion with Tim Baldwin about the time frame
        - Could it be November or December?
      - Joe Janz will reach out and make an introduction
        - Joe does not have the authority to make the final decision, but could "broker" the process
        - Encourage Tim Hunt and Jason Stickell to talk to Davenport Archers
          - They are the head coaches with the decision power
      - Eldridge Ministries "Hot Shots"
        - Would this be a second option?

- Facility is needed from November to April annually
  - Would appreciate 1 night a week for YSSA athletes to use it
- Where are the majority of the athletes from?
  - o Illinois?
  - o lowa?
    - Consider distance when finding a new location, but then again "beggars can't be choosers"
  - North Scott Team practices?
  - Bettendorf location is better but again depends on where the kids are coming from
- We would not want to grow the team and then need to shut it down
  - o Archery has an outdoor location Bi-State Sportsman's Club
    - Bi-State does not charge YSSA to use the open field
      - Bi-State leaves the land available to YSSA

## **Holiday Raffle**

- Joe Janz typically leads the charge on this, but for now let's leave this on the "back burner"
  - o Don't want to bring in money and then not have a club for the kids to compete at

Bill Peterson will reach out to Tim Baldwin about the time frame in which YSSA would need to vacate

- Kent Keeshan encourages the Archery team to pursue other viable options for a new indoor range
  - Archery may need to create a committee and gather information to present to the YSSA Board
  - YSSA Archery is encouraged to move forward on finding a new option sooner than later
    - If the building sells, YSSA may be asked to vacate immediately
      - Does YSSA have a lease agreement with the location or is it only verbal?
- Once we have a time frame from Tim, YSSA will have a better grasp on what to do next
