

YSSA September 13, 2021 Board Meeting Minutes

Meeting was called to order at 6:03 pm

YSSA Accounts for Individual Athletes: (Answers to the questions from August meeting.)

- Is there an updated list? Joe Janz has added names to the accounts and has kept up on the Archery aspect of the YSSA accounts.
- Who is keeping track of the accounts? Bill is to keep track of this information through Quick Books, but coaches need to have access to this information, or it needs to be in a spreadsheet that can be updated quickly.
- Bill wants to talk to Steve Baxter as he has a name of someone who can help with Quick Books.
- What money is remaining in the athletes accounts from 2019? Kim Alman will send Bill Peterson the Excel Spreadsheet that was started in 2019.
- Remember YSSA did not collect dues in 2020 due to COVID. The decision was made to allow all of the athletes to remain active.

Shotgun Updates:

- Kyle Minneart will take some time to go to the ammunition storage place and provide a rough estimate as to what the team has for ammunition.
 - Kyle expressed that this is hard to count, but it is in an isolated area reserved for the YSSA Team.
 - To count the ammunition, it must be done during business hours for the convenience of the business owner who is permitting us to use the space at no cost.
 - Brian Alman has volunteered to help Kyle get a more accurate count on the ammunition.
 - Brian is requesting that Kyle provide him with a target date to do this.
 - Kyle will find a few option days and times that work best for the business owner and provide that to Brian.
- Kyle will begin a new shotgun course after September 20 with athletes who are interested in trying this sport.
- Don Collins has the 11 trophies and will be getting them engraved to be displayed at Bi-State.
 - Congratulations to all of those who supported and shot for YSSA. They did a fabulous job bringing in Midway USA money for the team endowment account.

Archery Updates:

- Jason Stickell and Tim Hunt have Level III Certifications in JOAD
- Eddy Boggs has officially stepped down from the position of Head Archery Coach for YSSA, but continues to volunteer his time and expertise to the team when he is able.
- Eddy Boggs has been nominated for a Director Position on the YSSA Board (9-13-2021).
 - Bill Peterson nominated Eddy to the Board Position

- Brian Alman seconded the nomination.
 - All in Favor, none opposed
 - Eddy is on the Board - CONGRATULATIONS!!!

 - When practice will take place - beginning date and times
 - Notifications about practices will be done by Steve
- **Joe Janz had put out a press release about the YSSA Club and it appears that several have made contact and are getting directions for this event.**
 - Thank you Joe for promoting the club so successfully!
 - **The cost for this was \$100.00 for 7 days of advertisement**
 - **The YSSA Board agreed that this was money well spent.**

 - Community posts are generated and have been tagging others in the area to promote further interest
 - Facebook calls are being directed to Bill Peterson
 - **There is a 10% discount for new members signing up on registration night**
- Jason and Kim Stickell will be coordinating this event.
 - They will collect registration fees if the families write a check.
 - Bill Peterson will not be attending due to the rise in COVID numbers in Illinois
 - Jason Stickell has purchased water and chips for the event. For reimbursement, please get receipts to Bill Peterson.
 - Kyle Minneart plans to attend this event and introduce the 6 week shotgun safety learning course
 - Kyle will see how many are interested?
 - Kyle will explain when the course will begin.
 - **Archery** will be permitted during the registration to try at a 10 yard shot
 - The hope is to further promote excitement for the sport and team.
 - **Shotgun** - Brian Alman and Steve Baxter will be there to represent and promote the Shotgun team.
- **Still no coach for Rifle, Air Rifle, and Pistol team**
 - This might need to be put on the back burner, until we have a more defined leader and a schedule to present
 - Tom Davidson from PV has volunteered to talk to Bill about this aspect of YSSA and possibly be a coach for it.
 - He is looking for additional details, time commitment, and support.

Holiday Raffle?

- At this time, this is on HOLD due to the uncertainty of future archery range availability.
 - It is not right, to encourage athletes to join a club and then not have a range for practice.
 - We cannot in good faith do a raffle and collect money when there are unknown factors.
 - This will be revisited once we have additional information concerning the future of the archery indoor range options.
